THE KEYS TO OUR STUDENTS' SUCCESS

An **INITIAL TEST**, complete with parent **Briefing**, helps determine the Spanish school year and evaluate personal needs.

An **INDUCTION COURSE**, held before departure, provides a head-start in elocution and communication skills to help secure sufficient tools to **participate actively** in class (homework in

Spanish, phonetics, vocabulary back-up and guidance).

A short **PREPARATORY COURSE**, arranged on arrival, ensures **smooth integration** into the Spanish school structure and the Spanish way of life.

A range of **WELCOMING SCHOOLS** guarantees good ethos; details of which are confirmed at the end of the Dublin Induction Course.

REGULAR VISITS, with tuition granted by our Local Representative help the Irish student keep up with homework, as well as other tasks assigned for backup. These also provide **emotional support** and vetting.

This programme is ideal for **TY students** wishing to improve their **fluency**.

An **induction course** in pronunciation, grammar and Spanish phonetics is held before departure, to instil confidence.

Irish student’s levels in Spanish are not critical; but motivation is a prerequisite.

Family accommodation is at a **student’s home**

(subject to availability).

Placement can only be initiated after enrolment has been received and the test and the interview conducted.

Extension of weeks or terms are better confirmed on initial enrolment.

As June is a period of exams in Spain, places are limited and reserved to Irish students extending their stay.

The July **Diálogos** course is open to **5th Year** students wishing to boost grammar and writing, ahead of the Leaving Cert (please ask for separate brochure).

We reserve the right to refuse an enrolment for reasons we deem valid. A copy of the student’s Junior Cert results is requested and the student’s school may be contacted for reference.

LAND TRANSFERS & INSURANCE

Preparatory Course & Supervised group return from local Spanish Airport to Preparatory Centre, to respective family and back to Airport @ €185, payable to *Odyssée Internationale*. Parents are at liberty to organize transfers independently (a discharge is required for unsupervised transfers).

European Health Insurance Card to be applied for from Health Board. Parents are responsible for providing their child with medical insurance.


